Product License Agreement
Security Blanket(TM)

This Is A License, Not A Sale

The software product which you have elected to license on a fully functional basis is provided by Trusted Computer Solutions, Inc. ("TCS") under the following license agreement (the "Agreement") which defines what you (the "Licensee") may do with the product and contains limitations on warranties and remedies. This document is a legal agreement between you and TCS. Please read this Agreement carefully and indicate your agreement by clicking on I ACCEPT below. You will not be able to obtain a license key that activates the full functionality of the Product unless you accept this Agreement and pay the applicable License Fee. If you are not willing to be bound by this Agreement, do not proceed with your purchase of a license to the Product.

Software And Documentation

Product. The Product is a commercial software product developed and marketed by TCS named, Security Blanket(TM) (the "Product").

Documentation. The documentation that was or may be downloaded with the trial version of the Product (the "Documentation") is the user documentation for the Product.

Ownership. Licensee acknowledges and agrees that TCS is and shall remain the sole owner of all rights, title, and interest in the Product and Documentation, including but not limited to copyright, patent, trade secret, trademark, and other intellectual property rights.

License

License. Conditioned upon receipt of the applicable License Fee and full compliance with this Agreement, TCS grants Licensee a nonexclusive, nontransferable license (the "License") to use the

full functionality of the Product and Documentation on a single network server, and also to print one copy of the Documentation, in accordance with the terms stated in this Agreement, and solely for Licensee's internal computing purposes, on a permanent basis unless the License is terminated as provided below.

Backup Copies. Licensee is authorized to make one copy of the Product for backup purposes. Full and partial system saves which include the Product may be made for archival purposes, provided that any restores are performed back onto the original computer or workstation from which the Product saves were taken. No copies may be made of the Documentation.

E-Mail And Telephone Support Only. TCS will provide a reasonable level of e-mail and telephone support for the use of the Product in accordance with this Agreement. Apart from such e-mail and telephone support, TCS shall have no obligation to correct any bugs, defects, or errors in the Product, make any modifications or enhancements to the Product, maintain the Product, or otherwise provide any type of support for the Product.

U. S. Government Restricted Rights. The Product is a "commercial item" as defined in the FAR (48 CFR 2.101), consisting of "commercial computer software" and "commercial computer software documentation," as those terms are used in the FAR and DFARS (48 CFR 2.212 and 48 CFR 227.7202-1 through 227.7202-4). The Product and Documentation are provided to the U.S. Government solely under the terms of this standard commercial software license agreement. The contractor is Trusted Computer Solutions, Inc., 2350 Corporate Park Drive, Suite 500, Herndon, VA 20171.

Termination. The License shall automatically and immediately terminate if Licensee commits a material breach of this Agreement. Upon termination of the License, Licensee agrees to uninstall, erase, and/or otherwise permanently delete all copies of the Product and Documentation from Licensee's computer equipment, including all storage media, except for archived back-ups, and to destroy Licensee's print copy of the Documentation if one was made.

Restrictions

No Unauthorized Copying. Licensee shall not make any copies of the Product or Documentation except as necessary to use the Product as expressly permitted in this Agreement.

No Transfer, Etc. Licensee shall not sublicense, sell, lease, assign, pledge, permit use of, give, lend, distribute, disclose, or otherwise transfer the Product, Documentation, or copies thereof.

No Modification. Licensee shall not modify, enhance, alter, or prepare derivative works based on the Product or Documentation.

No Reverse Engineering. Licensee shall not decompile, decode, unlock, disassemble, or otherwise attempt to reverse engineer or discover the source code of the Product.

No Competitive Use. During the term of the License and for two years after termination of the License for any reason, Licensee shall not develop, market, or support, nor provide information or assistance to others in developing, marketing, or supporting, any software product which is competitive with the Product or incorporates or makes use of any of the trade secrets contained in the Product or Documentation.

No Commercial Use. Licensee shall not use the Product to provide service bureau, time-sharing, application service provider, or comparable services to any other party.

Proprietary Notices. Licensee shall not remove, alter, or obscure TCS' copyright, trademark, trade secret, or other proprietary notices, legends, or designators from the Product, Documentation, or media on which they were provided by TCS.

No Export. Licensee shall not export or otherwise remove the Product from the United States.

Disclaimers And Exclusions

Verification Of Results. Licensee acknowledges that the Product provides certain information about Licensee's system but does not provide professional expertise or judgment, and that it may not operate properly in all respects. Licensee agrees to test and verify all results of the Product before relying or acting on them.

No Warranty. The Product and Documentation are provided "AS IS" and without warranty of any kind. TCS disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, and all warranties relating to the performance, quality, results, security, use of, or inability to use the Product or Documentation. TCS does not warrant that the Product or Documentation will be suitable for licensee's purposes, will be error-free, will operate without interruption, or will provide adequate data security.

Exclusion Of Damages. In no event shall TCS be liable to Licensee or any third party for any damages, whether in contract or tort (including negligence) or arising under any other legal theory, arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the performance, quality, results, security, use of, or inability to use the Product or Documentation. This exclusion extends to all damages, including but not limited to direct, consequential, special, indirect, incidental, punitive, and exemplary damages, and to all claims by Licensee, whether for its own damages or for indemnity for claims brought by third parties, or by any other party.

Technical Protections. The Product may contain technical protections that restrict use to certain equipment or to a single server, and may provide other restrictions, all of which shall be consistent with the License. TCS shall not be liable for any damages incurred as a result of such technical protections or the failure of the Product to operate outside the scope of the License.

General

Reservation Of Rights. TCS reserves to itself all rights not expressly granted in this Agreement.

No Assignment. Licensee shall not assign, subcontract, delegate, or otherwise transfer any of the rights or obligations arising under this Agreement.

Applicable Law And Jurisdiction. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Virginia, without giving effect to choice of law principles. The parties consent to personal jurisdiction and venue before the state and federal courts serving Fairfax County, Virginia, with respect to any disputes arising under this Agreement or in connection with the Product of Documentation.

Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable to any extent, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect and the unenforceable provision shall be enforced to the fullest extent permissible and/or reformed to express the original intention of the parties as closely as possible.

Amendment And Waiver. The provisions of this Agreement may only be amended, supplemented, or waived by a later writing signed by the parties. The waiver of any specific right or claim under this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of any other right or claim.

Entire Agreement. This document contains the complete, final, and exclusive agreement of the parties concerning its subject and supersedes all earlier oral or written agreements, representations, promises, negotiations, and other communications between the parties.
