The DTSS collects, stores, manages, creates, updates and disseminates geospatial data, information, and products used by both Army Battle Command and the Distributed Common Ground System – Army (DCGS-A). There are currently more than 400 DTSS systems fielded to the Active Army and National Guard Brigade Combat Teams, Stryker Brigades, Special Forces Groups and at Division, Corps and Theater commands.
