Corticon's access to Oracle EBS data isolates changing data requirements for automated decisions, which translates into superior agility and business control.

Leveraging Oracle EBS data

Corticon's EDC Application Connector for Oracle EBS employs Composite Software's Application Data Services[™] for Oracle EBS, which deliver Oracle EBS content as pre-built, reusable data services. Oracle EBS data is invaluable not only within the system, but also in the larger context of your enterprise. For example, by combining accounting data from Oracle EBS with legacy GL systems, you can implement decisions that validate financial policy compliance and integrity.

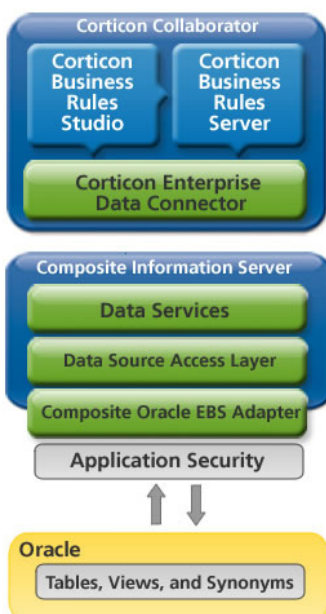
Business-friendly access for rule authors

Adhering to user responsibilities and Oracle's strict security constraints, Data Services allow Oracle EBS data to be mapped to Corticon business rules vocabularies, and to be delivered to the Corticon Business Rules Server through Corticon EDC-generated queries. Data Services for SAP deliver high-level abstracts of the most common business objects, such as Invoices, Journals, and Bill of Materials, making these objects available to rule authors as familiar business entities.
