STATE OF OKLAHOMA AMENDMENT NO. 6 TO STATEWIDE CONTRACT WITH CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY CORP.

This Sixth Amendment to Oklahoma Statewide Contract No. 1041 (the “Sixth Amendment”) is effective as of the date of the last signature below, between the State of Oklahoma by and through the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (“State”) and **Carahsoft Technology Corp.** (“Supplier”). This First Amendment supplements and amends the State of Oklahoma Statewide Contract No. 1041 with **Carahsoft Technology Corp.** entered into by the parties and effective on October 26, 2023, (the “Contract”), including all supplements and amendments thereto. Unless otherwise indicated, capitalized terms used in this Sixth Amendment without definition shall have the respective meanings specified in the Contract.

For good and valuable consideration, the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. Supplier and State desire to amend the Contract (as defined in the Contract) to modify the Term of the Contract. Accordingly, the parties agree that the Term of the Contract shall be amended to end on **August 30, 2030**, and all references in the Contract to the expiration or end date shall be deemed to refer to such amended date.
2. Supplier and State desire to amend the Contract (as defined in the Contract) to include the following definition under Attachment B, Section 4, *Definitions*:
 - a. “**Subcontractor** means any third party engaged by Supplier to provide products, services, or solutions that Supplier resells, supplies, or otherwise makes available to the State under this Contract.”
3. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions hereof and the terms and conditions of the Contract, the specific terms set forth in this Sixth Amendment shall govern the subject matter herein.
4. Except as expressly modified in this Sixth Amendment, all terms and/or provisions of the Contract not addressed herein remain as executed by the parties in the Contract and remain in full force and effect.
5. This Sixth Amendment may be executed by electronic signature in counterparts (e-mail, facsimile or otherwise). The counterparts each of which shall constitute an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
