WEB PROTECTION SUITE

Symantec Web Protection Suite ("WPS") is provided under the following terms and conditions in addition to any terms and conditions referenced herein, on the CA quote, order form, statement of work, or other mutually agreed ordering document (each a "Transaction Document") under the applicable end user agreement or governing contract (collectively, the "Agreement") entered into by Customer and the CA entity ("CA") through which Customer obtained a license for WPS. These terms shall be effective from the effective date of such Transaction Document.

1. DEFINITIONS

CA may count any and all of the following as a "**User**": (a) any employee of the Customer, (b) any agent, partner/contractor resource, or other non-employee (i.e., each individual person) authorized by Customer to use and/or benefit from the use of the Service, and (c) each 8 gigabytes of Customer's total Service activity/traffic transferred per month, excluding activity/traffic of any person already counted as a "User" under subsections (a) and (b). A User may have up to four (4) devices.

2. USE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS

A. Customer may use WPS for the number of Users as set forth in the Transaction Document.
