- By a person with intent to sign





State of the Law

- ESIGN Act
- UETA
- Colorado Adopts UETA (with some modifications)
- Article 71.1 of the State Administrative Procedure Act

Classic UETA Exceptions

- Consumer transactions require consent and opt-out rights
- Wills, family documents
- Court documents made under oath*
- Negotiable instruments

Colorado Additions

- Identity verification/Attribution requirements
- Security requirements


Exceptions in Colorado - Takeaway

- Exceptions do not necessarily mean that electronic signatures cannot be used, just that UETA does not apply.
- Largely consumer-based, personal transactions
- When in doubt, seek consent. (DocuSign does this by default).



<p>Court's Focus: Clickwraps</p> <p>Issue: Whether a clickwrap agreement is enough to compel arbitration?</p> <p>Holding: Yes, but evidence problems...</p> <p>Takeaway: Multiple forms of authentication increase attribution confidence and reduce chance of later litigation</p>	<p>Court's Focus: Technology</p> <p>Issue: Whether a eSignature product that hid certain terms of a contract rendered that contract unenforceable?</p> <p>Holding: Yes.</p> <p>Takeaway: Don't build your own e-sign software</p>	<p>Court's Focus: Intent</p> <p>Issue: Whether an email constitutes "electronic signature" under ESIGN?</p> <p>Holding: Not in this case</p> <p>Takeaway: Put in place a system of signature authority and approval workflows.</p>	<p>Court's Focus: DocuSign</p> <p>Issue: Whether the use of DocuSign is a valid means of entering into a lease in California</p> <p>Holding: Yes.</p> <p>Takeaway: DocuSign is recognized by courts across the world as a credible electronic signature provider</p>
